Arriving to Oslo by sea is something really special. The capital of Norway lies in the heart of Scandinavia at the head of the Oslofjord. All visitors enjoy the entrance and departure sights along this fjord.

Dominating the harbour is Akershus Fortress, a medieval castle and royal residence built in 1299. The main cruise port is next to the fortress and approximately 200 metres from the city centre and the City Hall with an exciting waterfront with shops, restaurants and entertainment.

From 2008 all cruise passengers will be able to marvel at the new Opera House - Oslo's latest cultural supplement situated at the heart of the port area.

Oslo is part of the Baltic and Norwegian cruise destinations and 2008 appears to set a record with 138 cruise calls with 240.000 passengers.
